

RESOLUTION NO. 627

EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION - SHERIFF

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on June 7th, 1976, declaring there were insufficient funds in the 1976 budget to hire an additional three jailors, thereby placing two jailors on day and swing shifts to provide minimum acceptable security and safety for jail personnel and prisoners, and;

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the extension to the Sheriff's 1976 budget to cover this request in the amount below:

Salaries (3)	\$19,887.00
Benefits (3)	<u>3,380.79</u>
TOTAL	\$23,267.79 for remaining 7 months.

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Emergency Budget Extension be held at 11:00 A.M., Monday, June 21, 1976, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Emergency Budget Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above Emergency Budget Extension in the amount \$23,267.79 must be appropriated, for the above purpose at such time as requested by that Department.
