

RESOLUTION NO. 643

EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION - JUVENILE PROBATION OFFICE

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on July 1, 1976, declaring there were insufficient funds in the 1976 budget to cover detention costs for the remainder of the calendar year; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the extension to the Juvenile Probation Officers' 1976 budget to cover this request in the amount below:

\$3,234.00 for detention costs for remainder of 1976

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Emergency Budget Extension be held at 11:30 A. M., Monday, July 19, 1976 at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Emergency Budget Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above Emergency Budget Extension in amount \$3,234.00 must be appropriated for the above purpose, and the County Treasurer is HEREBY DIRECTED to transfer said sum from the General Current Expense Fund.

FURTHER: Said \$3,234.00 is to be a maximum figure and is to be used for detention costs only, and NOT TRANSFERRABLE to any other budget category.
