COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION No. 645

COUNTY ROAD PROJECT No. 820

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 5767 known locally as the Mc Reavy Road, and more specifically located in Sections 5 & 8, TS 21, Range 3, M.P. 1.87 to M.P. 2.56, work defined as "construction" in the RARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is identified as #103 & 203 on the officially adopted county annual road program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to reconstruct 0.69 mile; principal quantities are:

Clearing & Grubbing	4 Acres
Roadway Excavation	22,000 Cu. Yds.
Gravel Base Class "B"	2,900 Cu. Yds.
Crushed Surf. Top Course	1,000 Cu. Yds.
Schedule "A" Culv. Pipe	400 Lin. Ft.

and that said work is to be performed by (~~day labor~~) (contract) in accordance with the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:

Engineering	\$ <u>8,000.00</u>
Right-of-Way	<u>4,500.00</u>
Road Construction	<u>46,000.00</u>
Bridge Construction	<u> </u>

Engineer's Estimate in detail is on file in the office of the County Engineer.

The County Road Project herein described is HEREBY DECLARED to be a public necessity, and the County Road Engineer is HEREBY ORDERED AND AUTHORIZED to report and proceed thereon as by law, provided, and in accordance with WAC 136-18.
