

RESOLUTION NO. 647

WHEREAS, there is a need for reduced speed on County roads during construction and for various other reasons of a temporary nature during emergencies, and

WHEREAS, such reduced speeds are necessary in order to protect the traveling public and/or the integrity of the road, and

WHEREAS, it may not be feasible to wait until the next Board meeting for an ordinance to be passed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Engineer is hereby authorized, after careful engineering study and decision, to order such a temporary speed limit reduction and to cause the road to be posted accordingly. Further, the County Engineer shall notify the Board of any such action at its next regularly scheduled meeting.
