

RESOLUTION NO. 664

EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION - CIVIL SERVICE

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on September 7, 1976, declaring there were insufficient funds in the 1976 budget to hire professional examiners to conduct the civil service examinations for the Mason County Sheriff's Office, and;

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the extension to the budget to cover this request in the amount below:

\$500.00 total estimated amount needed  
\$50.00 per examiner, - 3 examiners needed for each examination

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Emergency Budget Extension be held at 10:45 A.M., September 20th, 1976, Monday, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Emergency Budget Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above Emergency Budget Extension in the amount \$500.00 must be appropriated, for the above purpose at such time as requested by that Department.
