

RESOLUTION NO. 665

WHEREAS, on September 13, 1976, the County Commissioners were advised that the County Treasurer had received the amount of \$281,666.75, which has been credited to the Federal Forest Fund; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners to allocate 50% of the Federal Forest Funds to the Mason County School Districts and 50% to the Mason County Road Fund; and

WHEREAS, on September 27, 1976, the Board did receive from the Superintendent of Intermediate School District No. 113, his recommendations for the distribution of the 50% which goes to the various school districts of Mason County, in total amount of \$140,833.37;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved that the County Treasurer be hereby directed to credit the County Road Fund with \$140,833.38, and to make the following distribution of \$140,833.37 to the Mason County School District Funds as follows:
