

RESOLUTION NO. 667

WHEREAS, on September 29, 1976, a Petition was presented to the County Auditor, signed by 21 registered voters of Tahuya Precinct, (Tahuya River Valley Plat, Division No. 1 through Division No. 7), wherein they requested formation of a Fire Protection District, as provided under RCW 52.04.030; and

WHEREAS, according to said law, the County Auditor did, on Monday, October 4, 1976, transmit said Petition, together with a Certificate of Sufficiency as to number and validity of signatures on said Petition and an Obligation Statement, dated October 4, 1976, wherein two principal Petitioners did obligate themselves to the extent of publication costs for the publications necessary for said formation and the ensuing election;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners does hereby receive the above Petition and other papers presented by the County Auditor, and does hereby fix Monday, October 25, 1976 at the hour of 11:00 A. M. as date of public Hearing on said Petition, and directs the Clerk of the Board to publish and post the necessary Notices of said Hearing, as required by RCW 52.04.150.
