

RESOLUTION NO. 704

WHEREAS, the speed limits on county roads in Mason County, Washington were fixed by Resolution on January 9, 1956 as 35 miles per hour except certain roads as otherwise posted, and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1962, said Resolution was amended to fix the maximum speed limit of 45 miles per hour on all county roads, unless otherwise posted; and

WHEREAS, existing conditions on a portion of Old Belfair Highway (County Road #9825) warrant a speed limit of 25 miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that said portion of Old Belfair Highway #9825 lying between mile posts 3.27 (intersection Bear Creek Road #7980 and Old Belfair Highway) and thence north to mile post 3.68 be posted at 25 miles per hour effective immediately and the County Engineer is directed to erect the necessary 25 miles per hour signs on said road in conformity herewith.
