

RESOLUTION NO. 710

ESTABLISHMENT OF
ANTIRECESSION FISCAL AID FUND

WHEREAS, as a result of the adoption of P.L. 94-369 by Congress, Countercyclical (Antirecession) Payments will be made to states, counties, cities and towns where the unemployment rate is over 4.5%; and

WHEREAS, the law sets up a total of five quarterly payments (if the upper limit of the appropriation isn't reached earlier) to eligible governments; and

WHEREAS, Mason County has now received payment for the last two quarters of 1976, in amount \$36,309.00, and the County Commissioners desire these monies to be kept separate from the Federal Shared Revenue Funds;

THEREFORE, be it hereby Resolved and Ordered by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that the Mason County Treasurer be hereby directed to establish a fund to be known as the "Antirecession Fiscal Aid Fund", into which these monies will be deposited until such time as they are allocated by the Board of County Commissioners.
