

RESOLUTION NO- 719

WHEREAS, the speed limits on county roads in Mason County, Washington were fixed by Resolution on January 9, 1956 as 35 miles per hour except certain roads as otherwise posted, and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1962, said Resolution was amended to fix the maximum speed limit of 45 miles per hour on all county roads, unless otherwise posted; and,

WHEREAS, existing conditions on a portion of Old Olympic Highway #1131 warrant a speed limit of 35 miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that said portion of Old Olympic Highway #1131 lying between Shelton-Olympia Freeway and State Highway 108 (Kamliche Cut-off) be posted at 35 miles per hour effective immediately and the County Engineer is directed to erect the necessary 35 miles per hour signs on said road in conformity herewith.
