

RESOLUTION NO. 743

ESTABLISHMENT OF PETTY CASH OR WORKING FUNDS  
DISTRICT COURT

WHEREAS, the Clerks in the District Court Office accept fines and forfeitures which many times necessitates the making of change; and

WHEREAS, the District Court Judge, Carol Fuller, has requested that a "Petty Cash or Working Fund", in amount \$25.00, be set up for each of her Clerks (three in number) in order to facilitate making change;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Mason County, Washington, that the establishment of a "Petty Cash or Working Fund" is necessary for each Clerk making change, in amount \$25.00 for each, and that authorization be hereby granted to the District Court Judge to voucher for the \$75.00 from her budget for 1977 to be utilized for this purpose; that each of these "Petty Cash or Working Fund" accounts be balanced each day, and a monthly report be made to the Mason County Auditor of these funds.
