RESOLUTION NO. 750-A

WHEREAS, an election was held on April 5, 1977, for a portion of Lilliwaup Precinct, at which election the voters in the Lilliwaup area located in the following: All lands southerly of the Jefferson County southerly line within the sections bordering U.S. Hwy. #101 thence south to the northerly border of the Hoodspport Fire Protection Dist. #1 of Mason County. This area is encompassed by the following list of sections of land in Mason County.

Section 6 T24N R2W excluding Govt. Lot #1, Sections 1, 12, 12, S $\frac{1}{2}$  of 22, 23, 24, 26, 34, in T24N R3W, Sections 3, 9, 10, 16, 17, in T23N R3W, and the protion of Section 20 T23N R3W lying northerly of the Hoodspport Fire Protection District #1 northerly border.

WHEREAS, all of said requirements relating to the formation of Fire Protection Districts, under Chapter 52.04 RCW, have been accomplished; and

WHEREAS, the official canvass of said election shows 112 votes for and 10 votes against the formation of the District;

THEREFORE, since a majority vote is required for such formation the election therefore passed.
