NONDEBATABLE EMERGENCY  
DOUBLE ENTRY BOOKKEEPING EQUIPMENT  
AUDITOR

WHEREAS, State Law mandates that all Counties go into double entry bookkeeping this year; and

WHEREAS, in order to accomplish this mandate, hardware and software must be added to our bookkeeping machine, and training is needed; and

WHEREAS, there is no money in the 1977 budget to cover these expenditures as they were not anticipated at the time of the budget adoption;




Hardware, Software for Bookkeeping
