

RESOLUTION NO. 765
SPEED LIMIT
Shelton-Matlock Road No. 9010

WHEREAS, the speed limits on county roads in Mason County, Washington were fixed by Resolution on January 9, 1956 as 35 miles per hour except certain roads as otherwise posted; and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1962, said Resolution was amended to fix the maximum speed limit as 45 miles per hour on all county roads, unless otherwise posted; and

WHEREAS, after recommendation by the County Engineer, and a public Hearing held May 31, 1977, at the hour of 2:00 P. M. at which time no objections were received

IT WAS THEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners, that the portion of the Shelton-Matlock Road No. 9010, lying between the intersection of the Shelton Valley Road No. 0593, and thence east to the Goldsborough Bridge, be posted at 35 miles per hour, effective immediately, and the County Engineer directed to erect the necessary 35 miles per hour signs on said road in conformity herewith.
