

RESOLUTION NO 798

EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION - Juvenile Court

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on September 6th, 1977, and,

WHEREAS, unanticipated expenditures have arisen in the Mason County Juvenile Court budget for 1977, and,

WHEREAS, the total grant amount will be \$2,500.00 for the remainder of the year 1977, and in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the \$2,500.00 Emergency Extension to the Juvenile Court, and

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Emergency Budget Extension be held at 2:00 P.M. September 6th, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Emergency Budget Extension.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that the emergency extension to the Juvenile Court Fund Budget in amount of \$2,500.00 be authorized.
