

RESOLUTION NO 800

EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION - General Admin.

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on September 19, 1977, declaring there were insufficient funds in the 1977 General Administration budget to cover the cost of a lawn mower and Capital Outlay, and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the requested Emergency Budget Extension in the following amount:

\$342.62 for lawn mower - Capital Outlay

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Emergency Budget Extension be held at 11:30 A.M. October 3, 1977, Monday, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Emergency Budget Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above Emergency Budget Extension in amount of \$342.62 must be appropriated for the above purpose.
