

RESOLUTION NO. 805

SPEED LIMIT

Lake Nahwatzel
(Matlock Road)

WHEREAS, the speed limits on county roads in Mason County, Washington were fixed by Resolution on January 9, 1956 as 35 miles per hour except certain roads as otherwise posted; and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1962, said RESolution was amended to fix the maximum speed limit as 45 miles per hour on all county roads, unless otherwise posted; and

WHEREAS, on June 6th, 1977, said Resolution was amended to fix the maximum speed limit as 25 miles per hour on that portion of the Matlock Road at Lake Nahwatzel from the east end of the lake to the west end of the lake, and

WHEREAS, after a public Hearing held on September 26th, 1977 at the hour of 10:30 A.M. at which time no objections were received

IT WAS THEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners, that the portion of the Matlock Road at Lake Nahwatzel, from the east end of the lake to the west end of the lake, be posted at 35 miles per hour, effective immediately, and the County Engineer directed to erect the necessary 35 miles per hour signs on said road in conformity herewith.
