

RESOLUTION NO. 819

REIMBURSABLE EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION - Sheriff

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on October 31, 1977, declaring there were insufficient funds in the 1977 budget to cover salaries and Wages for one Deputy from 10/1/77 through 12/31/77, and

WHEREAS, the amount to be reimbursed to the County of Mason, by the Forest Service Agreement with the U. S. Department of Agriculture and the Simpson Timber Company of Shelton and upon invoicing through the Sheriff's Department in the amount of,

521-20-10 Salaries and Wages - \$3,458.64

WHEREAS, it appears that the request is reasonable and necessary;

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Reimbursable Emergency Budget Extension be held at 11:00 A.M. Monday, November 14, 1977 at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above Reimbursable Emergency Budget Extension in the amount of \$3,458.64 must be appropriated for the above purpose, and the County Treasurer directed to deposit \$3,458.64 to the Current Expense Fund when the grant monies are received.
