

RESOLUTION NO 824

REIMBURSABLE EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION - CETA 1

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on November 14, 1977, declaring there were insufficient funds in the 1977 budget to cover salary for one CETA 1 position, and

WHEREAS, the amount to be reimbursed to the County of Mason, by the State in the amount of,

\$3,607 Salary

WHEREAS, in the judgement of the County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for this expenditure, and the request is reasonable and necessary;

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Reimbursable Emergency Budget Extension be held at 11:00 A.M., Monday, November 28, 1977 in their office in the County Courthouse, to consider granting said Budget, and at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgement of the Board the above Reimbursable Emergency Budget Extension in the amount of \$3,607.00 must be appropriated for the above purpose.
