RESOLUTION NO. 845

SENIOR CENTER

A RESOLUTION relating to recreation and leisure-time activities plus information and referral services for senior citizens and authorizing a contract with the Senior Center of Mason County to provide said services to eligible citizens of Mason County.

WHEREAS, there are citizens of Mason County of the age of 60 years or over, many of whom because of their age, are in need of comprehensive structured and unstructured recreation and leisure-time activities plus information and referral services to enable them to better utilize existing community resources; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interests of the health and welfare of the citizens of Mason County for the County to provide such activities and services for its senior citizens, aged 60 years and older; and

WHEREAS, the Senior Center of Mason County is a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Washington and is qualified and willing to provide said activities and perform said services pursuant to contract with Mason County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MASON COUNTY, that a contract be entered into with the Senior Center of Mason County in the form attached hereto for providing comprehensive structured and unstructured recreation and leisure-time activities plus information and referral services to enable a better utilization of existing community resources to the senior citizens of Mason County of the age of 60 years or over.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mason County Commissioners hereby delegate to the Mason County Director of Parks and Recreation the responsibility for the administration of said contract on behalf of Mason County.

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AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT between Mason County, hereinafter referred to as "County", and the SENIOR CENTER OF MASON COUNTY, a non-profit corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Center";

WITNESSETH:

That in consideration of the terms and conditions contained herein, the parties hereto covenant and agree as follows:

1. The Center agrees to provide services to senior citizens of Mason County of the age of sixty (60) years or older through the Senior Center in Shelton and two satellite operations in Kamilche and Belfair, said services to be limited to any or all of the following activities:

A. Provide comprehensive structured and unstructured recreation and leisure time activities for senior citizens on a continuous basis as follows:

- a. Recreation Opportunities, i.e. bingo, dances, exercises, card games, assertiveness training, reality orientation
- b. Socials
- c. Classes, i.e. hobbies, languages, crafts, money management, etc.
- d. Tours: bus excursions, sight-seeing trips
- e. Cottage Industries Outlet: marketing of items hand-made by Senior Citizens
- f. Musical Groups

B. Provide information and referral services to senior citizens to enable them to utilize the following existing community resources:

- a. Merchant Discount Program
- b. Legal Aide
- c. Counseling and Reassurance
- d. Telephone Reassurance
- e. Information Seminars
- f. Blood Pressure Monitoring
- g. Driver Safety
- h. Outreach Services
- i. Agency Referral
- j. Job Bureau
- k. Housing Assistance

C. Provide transportation on a call-on-demand basis at low or no cost to the senior citizen users as follows:

- a. Call-on-Demand pick-up
- b. Regular route service-rural
- c. Shopping assistance
- d. Escorting
- e. Medical and dental transportation
- f. Leisure travel

D. Provide for the delivery of direct services, including transportation, to the elderly by other public community agencies, and coordinate the delivery of such services within the Senior Center as follows:

- a. Shopping assistance
- b. Driver safety
- c. Escorting
- d. Call-on-demand transportation
- e. Income tax service
- f. Notary service
- g. Assistance with forms, i.e. medicare, medicaid, social security, SSI, property tax exemption, food stamps, public assistance
- h. Home aid
- i. Home maker service
- j. Maintenance and yard service

E. Provide meaningful volunteer opportunities for seniors as follows:

- a. Civic project
- b. Community resource opportunities
- c. Youth program assistance
- d. Handicap program planning
- e. Supportive service staff
- f. Recreation planning
- g. Transportation planning

2. The Center will submit to the County Commissioners monthly reports containing detailed information accounting for the County monies expended for services performed under this contract.

3. The Center will hold County harmless from all claims of every kind and character arising out of or in any way connected with the services being performed by it for the County and will, during the term of this contract, obtain and keep in full force and effect general liability insurance, with limits acceptable to the County, covering its operations performed under this contract on behalf of the County. The County shall be named insured under such policy, and a copy thereof will be filed with the County Clerk.

4. It is understood that the Center is an independent contractor and is not an agent of the County, and all personnel used by the Center in connection with the rendering of services contemplated by this contract shall be employees of the Center

and not the County, and shall have no claim against the County for compensation or other benefits available to the employees of said County.

5. The County will pay the Center for the services to be performed under this contract of the 1977 calendar year, a sum not to exceed FIVE THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$5,000.00), to be paid prorated monthly on vouchers to be presented by the Center to the County at the close of each month with the monthly report. Funds paid for such services will be used to furnish only the services contemplated by this contract and will not be diverted by the Center to any other person or used for any other purpose. Senior Center records of receipt and expenditure of such funds will be made available on reasonable request to County officials and the State Auditor for review.

6. This Agreement shall be for a term of one (1) year beginning January 1, 1977, and renewable for additional one year terms by mutual written consent of the parties.
