

RESOLUTION NO. 8-81

RENAMING OF COUNTY ROAD #5142

WHEREAS, on January 12, 1981, the Board of Mason County Commissioners held a public hearing to rename several county roads so that they would conform with the Addressing Program; and

WHEREAS, County Road No. 5142, Hemlock Place, was renamed to Acorn Place, at said hearing on January 12, 1981; and

WHEREAS, a petition signed by every citizen residing on said road was presented to the Board of Mason County Commissioners on January 19, 1981, which requested that the road name be changed to Noble Place; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interest of the citizens of Mason County to rename said road to Noble Place;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that County Road No. 5142, be renamed to Noble Place;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer is hereby directed to erect such signs as necessary to enact this resolution.
