

MASON COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 108-81
TO RECOGNIZE BLOMLIE ROAD AS COUNTY ROAD #80320

WHEREAS, per R.C.W. 36.75.070 "Highways worked seven years are county roads."
All public highways in this state, outside incorporated cities and towns and not designated as state highways, which have been used as public highways for a period of not less than seven years, where they have been worked and kept up at the expense of the public, are county roads,

AND WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners have determined to their satisfaction that this road in question, has been maintained at public expense by the County in excess of seven (7) years,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Board of Mason County Commissioners, that this road, located in Section 9, T22N, R2W, and lying south of the Northshore Road #9819 and west of the Landon Road #8030, and intersecting with both be named the Blomlie Road; be recognized as county maintained road No. 80320; and be established as a part of the Mason County Road System.
