

RESOLUTION NO. 109-81

RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO GRANT FRANCHISE AND NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, Mason County Board of Commissioners intends to grant a franchise for the purpose of providing cable television service to specific areas of Mason County; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have received an application to provide cable television service by Richard F. Buechel, owner and operator of UNION TELECABLE, residing at E 6500, Highway 106, Union, Washington, 98592; and

WHEREAS, Union Telecable has proposed to provide cable television service to the following areas of Mason County served by county roads:

Repositioning and maintaining cable television system from downtown Union, south on Seattle Street, East on Fifth to Port Townsend and South on Port Townsend to the crest of the ridge, as designated on map on file with the Board of County Commissioners.

WHEREAS, the franchise for cable television service sets forth provisions for a minimum number of viewing channels, plus additional terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Resolution Granting a Franchise is available in the Office of the County Auditor for review;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mason County Board of Commissioners that a call for Public Hearing is issued and is scheduled for 10:30 A.M., Monday, September 14, 1981, for the purpose of the citizens of Mason County to appear before the Board to express their interest in, or objections to, the granting of a franchise to Union Telecable. The Public Hearing will be held in the Commissioners' Chambers in the Mason County Courthouse.
