

ORDINANCE NO. 111-81

AMENDMENT TO MASON COUNTY CODE, CHAPTER 14.28
MASON COUNTY ADDRESSING ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of Mason County Commissioners, on December 17, 1979, adopted the Mason County Addressing Ordinance No. 1091, to establish a uniform road location and structure numbering system to reduce confusion of emergency or municipal service agencies in locating specific structures; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mason County Commissioners, on August 3, 1981, adopted Ordinance No. 92-81, which amends the Mason County Addressing Ordinance to make provision for exemptions of areas upon request of the residents therein if the present system of addresses in the area is adequate to meet the purposes of the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, on August 10, 1981, the Board of Mason County Commissioners held a public hearing to consider amending the Mason County Addressing Ordinance to reflect a more descriptive name of the quadrant boundaries, and to also amend certain language to clarify the total intent of the Addressing Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interest of the citizens of Mason County to make said amendments as discussed at the public hearing on August 10, 1981;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that the following amendments be made to the Mason County Code, Chapter 14.28:

Change Section 14.28.010 to read:

Title. This ordinance shall be known as and shall be cited as the Mason County Street Naming and Addressing Ordinance.

Change Section 14.28.020 to read:

Purpose. The intent of this ordinance is to establish road names which are not similar or same as by changing road names (reference to title) which are similar or same, road name change procedure, Mason County Chapter 12.12.010, as to set into force a numbering system.

Change Section 14.28.030 to read:

Scope. All roads and addressable structures as defined herein shall be subject to the minimum requirements of this chapter provided that the Mason County Board of Commissioners may exempt an area upon request of the residents therein if the present system of addresses in the area is adequate to meet the purposes of this Chapter.

Change Section 14.28.090 to read:

Districts. Mason County shall be divided into five districts as determined by the official map,

N-North District Boundary.

Beginning at a point which is common with the west shoreline of Hood Canal, T24N, T25N, R2W, W.M.; thence, westerly along the sixth standard parallel north to a point of intersection of the Grays Harbor County Boundary line; thence, in a southerly direction along a line common to R6W, and R7W, W.M. to a point common to T22N, and T21N, West W.M., thence; in an easterly direction along said township lines to a point of intersection with the South Fork of the Skokomish River; thence, in a southeasterly and easterly direction along center line of said river to a point of intersection with the south shoreline of Hood Canal; thence, in a westerly and northerly direction along said shoreline to the true point of beginning. All area being in Mason County, Washington.

W-West District

Beginning at a point which is common with the intersection of US Highway 101 and the Skokomish River; T21N, R4W, W.M.; thence in a westerly and northerly direction along said river to a point in common with T21N, T22N, R5W, W.M., thence, in a westerly direction along said township lines to a point which is in common to the northwest corner of Section 6, T21N, R6W, W.M.; thence, in a southerly direction on a line which is common to Grays Harbor and Mason Counties to the southwest corner of Section 31, T21N, R6W, W.M.; thence, easterly along a line common to T21N, R6W, and T22N, R7W all lying west of W.M. to a point on said line and common to the northwest corner of Section 6, T20N, R6W, W.M.; thence, in a southerly direction on a line which is common to Grays Harbor and Mason Counties to the southwest corner of Section 31, T19N, R6W, W.M.; thence in an easterly direction along said line common to T19N, T18N, W.W.M., to the southeast corner of Section 32, T19N, R3W, W.M.; thence in a northerly direction along a line which is common to Sections 32 and 33, T19N, R3W, W.M.; to a point of intersection with US Highway 101; thence, in a westerly and northerly direction along the center line of US Highway 101 to the intersection of US Highway 101 and the Skokomish River and the true point of beginning. All area being in Mason County, Washington.

SE-Southeast District

Beginning at a point which is common to the center line of US Highway 101 and a point on the east line of Section 32, T19N, R3W, W.M.; thence, in a northerly direction on Section Line common to Sections 32 and 33, T19N, R3W, W.M., to a point of intersection of said line and Mason County southeast boundary line; thence, in a northerly and easterly direction along said Mason County southeast boundary line to a point of intersection of a center line of Peale Passage; thence, in a northwesterly direction along said center line of Peale Passage to a point of intersection with the center line of Pickering Passage; thence, in a southerly direction along said center line of Pickering Passage to a point of intersection of a center line projection of Hammersley Inlet; thence, in a westerly direction along said center line of Hammersley Inlet to a northeast corner of Section 20, T20N, R3W, W.M.; thence, in a southerly direction to the southeast corner of Section 20, T20N, R3W, W.M., thence, in a westerly direction along said City of Shelton south boundary line to a center line point of intersection of US Highway 101; thence, in a southerly and easterly direction along said centerline of US Highway 101 to the true point of beginning. All area being in Mason County, Washington.

E-East District

Beginning at a point due west of the northeast corner of Section 20, T20N, R3W, W.M. which intersects and is common to the east boundary line of the City of Shelton T20N, R3W, W.M.; thence in an easterly direction along a center line of Hammersley Inlet to a point of intersection of the center line of Pickering Passage; in a northerly direction along said center line of Pickering Passage to a point of intersection of the center line of Peale Passage; thence, in a southeasterly direction along said center line of Peale Passage to a point of intersection in Dana Passage and Mason County line; thence, northeasterly along said Mason County line to a point of intersection with Mason, Thurston and Pierce Counties; thence, northerly along county line common to Pierce and Mason to the northeast Corner of Section 4, T22N, R1W, W.M.; thence, westerly on a common line between T23N and T22N, West W.M. to a point of intersection of the easterly shoreline of Hood Canal; thence, in a westerly and southerly direction along said south shoreline of Hood Canal to a point of intersection with the centerline of Skokomish River; thence, in a southerly and westerly direction along said river center line to a point of intersection with US Highway 101; thence, in a southerly direction along the center line of US Highway 101 to a point of intersection with the north Shelton City line; thence, easterly and southerly along

the City of Shelton boundary line to the true point of beginning. All area being in Mason County, Washington.

NE-Northeast District

Beginning at a point which is common to the northeast corner of Section 4, T24N and T23N, R1W, W.M.; thence, in a southerly direction along Section line to a common point of the southeast corner of Section 33, T23N and T22N, R1W, W.M.; thence, in a westerly direction along said township line common to T23N and T22N, W.M. to a point of intersection with the shoreline of Hood Canal; thence, in a northly, westerly then northerly direction along said Hood Canal shoreline to a point of intersection with a line common to T24N and T23N, R3W, W.M.; thence in an easterly direction along said Township line to the true point of beginning. All area being in Mason County, Washington.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this chapter shall be amended, in full force, and effective on August 10, 1981.
