

RESOLUTION NO. 115-81

RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO GRANT FRANCHISE AND
NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, The Board of Mason County Commissioners intends to grant a franchise for the purpose of providing cable television service to specific areas of Mason County; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have received an application to provide cable television service by Richard F. Buechel, owner and operator of Union Telecable, residing at E 6500 Highway 106, Union, Washington 98592; and

WHEREAS, Union Telecable has proposed cable television service to the following areas of Mason County served by county roads:

Township 21 North, Range 3 West, W.M.,
Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9

Township 21 North, Range 4 West, W.M.
Sections 1 and 12

Township 22 North, Range 2 West, W.M.
Sections 30 and 31

WHEREAS, the franchise for cable television service sets forth provisions for a minimum number of viewing channels, plus additional terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Resolution Granting Franchise is available in the Office of the County Auditor for review;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mason County Board of Commissioners that a call for Public Hearing is issued and is scheduled for 11:30 a.m., Monday, September 28, 1981, for the purpose of the citizens of Mason County to appear before the Board to express their interest in, or objections to, the granting of a franchise to Union Telecable. The Public Hearing is to be held in the Commissioners' Chambers in the Mason County Courthouse.
