COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION No. 122-81

COUNTY ROAD PROJECT No. 956

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 7039 known locally as the NORTHSHORE Road, and more specifically located in Section 34, T22N, R3W, W.M., M.P. to M.P. , work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is hereby made a part of the officially adopted county annual road program pursuant to RCW 36.81.130 and assigned Ø 20-B thereon.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to Install approximately 280 lineal feet of eighteen inch culvert pipe and two catch basins.

and that said work is to be performed by (day labor) (~~contract~~) in accordance with the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:

The County Road Project herein described is HEREBY DECLARED to be a public necessity, and the County Road Engineer is HEREBY ORDERED AND AUTHORIZED to report and proceed thereon as by law, provided, and in accordance with WAC 136-18.
