WHEREAS, the Board of Mason County Commissioners shares with the Governor and State Legislators the serious concerns of the State's current financial problems; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mason County Commissioners feels a strong responsibility to bring to the Governor and the State Legislators the concerns of Mason County citizens on this serious financial crisis in the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the financial problems of the State of Washington cannot be solved by charging ahead with the process of levying more and/or new taxes; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Mason County and the State of Washington have poignantly expressed their intent to see government and governmental leaders exercise fiscal responsibility through fiscal restraint; and

WHEREAS, the financial problems of the State of Washington can only be resolved through the judicious administration of fiscal programs that reflect the ability of the citizens to pay;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Mason County Commissioners respectfully requests the Governor and State Legislators to address the real financial problems of the State of Washington by not increasing the tax burdens upon our citizens; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Mason County Commissioners respectfully requests the Governor and State Legislators to reduce the governmental operations of the State of Washington to a level of financial operation that responsibly reflects the real income level of the State government.
