WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 9010 known locally as the Shelton-<u>Matlock</u> <u>the entire length of the road</u>, M.P. 3.20 to M.P. 28.06, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is identified as  $\oint 3-B$  on the officially adopted county annual road program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to have roadside obstructions removed under the Federal Hazard Elimination Program. Obstructions to be removed are essentially all stumps and trees which constitute a roadside impact hazard.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:
