COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION No. 133-81

COUNTY ROAD PROJECT No. 957

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 9010 known locally as the Shelton-Matlock Road, and more specifically located along the entire length of the road, M.P. 3.20 to M.P. 28.06, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is identified as # 3-B on the officially adopted county annual road program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to have roadside obstructions removed under the Federal Hazard Elimination Program. Obstructions to be removed are essentially all stumps and trees which constitute a roadside impact hazard.

and that said work is to be performed by (~~day labor~~) (contract) in accordance with the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:

The County Road Project herein described is HEREBY DECLARED to be a public necessity, and the County Road Engineer is HEREBY ORDERED AND AUTHORIZED to report and proceed thereon as by law, provided, and in accordance with WAC 136-18.
