RESOLUTION NO. 138, 1981

THE BOARD OF MASON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS finds as follows:

- I. Pursuant to R.C.W. 36.33.110, the State Treasurer has retained fifty percent (50%) of Mason County's share of Federal Forest Reserve Funds.

The State shall directly distribute these funds to the public schools.

- II. In past years, under the old law, the County Treasurer received the total County share of the Federal Forest Reserve Funds and distributed these funds fifty percent (50%) to public schools and fifty percent (50%) to County roads.

- III. The legislative authority of Mason County wishes to continue the past practice that fifty percent (50%) of the total funds be distributed to the public schools and fifty percent (50%) of the total funds be distributed to County roads.

- IV. Pursuant to R.C.W. 36.33.110, the Mason County Treasurer has received the first 1981 payment of Federal Forest Reserve Funds, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MASON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS in consideration of the above findings of fact:

1. The County Treasurer is directed hereafter to place all Federal Forest Reserve Funds received by the County into the County Road Fund.
