Pursuant to R.C.W. 36.33.110, the Mason County Treasurer has received the first 1981 payment of Federal Forest Reserve Funds, and NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MASON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS in consideration of the above findings of fact: The County Treasurer is directed hereafter to place all Federal Forest Reserve Funds received by the County into the County Road Fund.
