

RESOLUTION NO. 139-81

ORDER OF TRANSFER

WHEREAS, a petition for transfer into Fire Protection District 5 has been received from registered voters within Fire Protection District 3; and

WHEREAS, the County Auditor has filed a Certificate of Sufficiency stating that 100% of the qualified registered voters of the area to be transferred have signed said petition; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Commissioners of Fire Protection District 5 have accepted the petition for transfer;

WHEREAS, all requirements of RCW 52.08.060 have been fulfilled;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that the following area be transferred into Fire Protection District 5:

Part of Government Lot 4 in Section 27, T 21 N, R 2W, W.M.

The boundaries of said area being: On the North, by the North boundary of Tract 5-A which North boundary of Tract 5-A is described as: beginning at a point on the West line of said Government Lot 4, North 0° 09' 16" West 632.45 feet from the Southwest corner thereof, which is the True Point of Beginning; thence South 89° 13' 22" East, parallel with the South line of said Government Lot 4, 226.61 feet; thence North 51° 34' 19" East 126.54 feet; thence South 89° 13' 22" East, parallel with said South Line 80.47 feet, more or less, to the East line of said Government Lot 4, also, all the second-class tidelands lying South of said North line extended South 89° 13' 22" East, On the South by South boundary of said Section 27 On the East by Pickering Passage and, On the West by the West boundary of said Section 27.
