

RESOLUTION NO. 142-81

EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1981, it is necessary to make provision for emergency appropriations to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.140, to meet an outstanding obligation of the Superior Court Budget in the sum of \$15,000, to be expended as follows: \$500 to Telephone; \$500 to Professional Services; \$6,000 to Counsel - Criminal; and \$8,000 to Counsel - Juvenile.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners:

That the 9th day of November, 19 81, at the hour of 1:30 o'clock in the afternoon, the Board of County Commissioners of Mason County, at the County Courthouse, Shelton, Washington, be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the emergency appropriation to the budget for the Superior Court Fund in the estimated amount of \$ 15,000 for the above-mentioned purposes, and the Clerk of the Board be and hereby is authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.
