

WHEREAS, the Board of Health for Mason County on December 18, 1978, adopted the rules and regulations of the Thurston-Mason Health District effective January 1, 1979 according to RCW 70.05.060 (3); and

WHEREAS, a greater degree of protection of the public from foodborne illness will be achieved by these regulation changes.

WHEREAS, the Board of Health held a Public Hearing on November 3, 1981 for the purpose of considering amendments, deletions and additions to the Mason County Sanitary Code Article II.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the following amendments, deletions and additions to Mason County Sanitary Code, Article II, be adopted:

Delete Section 5.1 (b)

Add a new Section 5.1 (b)

ARTICLE II Section 5.1 (b)

- (b) Establish a specific and reasonable period of time for the correction of the violations found, in accordance with the following provisions:
- (1) When a demerit score of the establishment is 35 or less, all red item violations must be corrected immediately, and all blue item violations must be corrected by the time of the next routine inspection; or
 - (2) When the demerit score of the establishment is more than 35, but not more than 70, all red item violations must be corrected immediately, and all blue item violations must be corrected within a period of time not to exceed 30 days.
 - (3) When one or more "red item violations" are noted regardless of demerit score, such items must be corrected immediately.
 - (4) When the demerit score of the establishment is more than 70 red point items or 100 total points, the permit is immediately suspended.
 - (5) In the case of temporary food-service establishments, all blue item violations must be corrected within a specified period of time not to exceed 24 hours, and all red item violations must be corrected immediately. Failure to comply shall result in permit suspension.
 - (6) A closure notice must be posted conspicuously at the food service establishment by the health officer when closure is necessary as provided by this Article.

This Article shall be amended and shall be in full force and effective on November 3, 1981..
