

RESOLUTION NO. 150-81

EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1981, it is necessary to make provision for emergency appropriations to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.140, to meet an outstanding obligation of the Board of Equalization Budget in the amount of \$487.15, to Line Item Extra Help in the Salaries and Wages category.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners:

That the 23rd day of November, 19 81, at the hour of 11:00 o'clock in the morning, the Board of County Commissioners of Mason County, at the County Courthouse, Shelton, Washington, be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the emergency appropriation to the budget for the Board of Equalization Fund in the estimated amount of \$ 487.15 for the above-mentioned purposes, and the Clerk of the Board be and hereby is authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.
