

RESOLUTION NO. 178A-81

INTENT TO ESTABLISH

ECLER ROAD  
County Road No. 52370

WHEREAS, the State Department of Transportation has turned over to Mason County a portion of Old State Highway S.R. 3, located in the SE¼ of Section 35, Township 21 North, Range 3 West, W.M., as per attached State Highway map and has become a County road by action of law; and,

WHEREAS, the speed limits on County roads in Mason County, Washington, were fixed by Resolution on April 20, 1981, as 50 miles per hour, except certain roads as otherwise posted; and,

WHEREAS, Mason County needs to name this road which runs through a portion of donation land, Claim Number 38, obtained by Jacob O. Ecler; and,

WHEREAS, Mason County needs to establish a speed limit on this road of 25 M.P.H. for the full length of the road (0.28 miles); and,

NOW, THEREFORE, the County Engineer is hereby directed to report thereon and the Clerk of the Board shall fix a time and place for hearing the report as required by statute, and that the Prosecuting Attorney be requested to review and give approval to the steps herein ordered.
