

RESOLUTION NO. 18-81

AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION NO. 1121

STARTING SALARY FOR NEW EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, RCW 36.17.020 authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to establish the salaries of the County employees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mason County Commissioners:

Section 1: That starting salaries for new employees shall be as follows:

Starting Salary: \$700
After Six Months: \$750
After One Year: \$800

Section 2: That during the first year, new employees will not be eligible for any other pay increases.

Section 3: If an established position with specialized skills or qualifications becomes vacant, such position may be filled at a higher salary, subject to Board of County Commissioners approval. The salary for such position shall not exceed the annual appropriated amount; probation period will be in effect.

Section 4: That if part-time employee becomes eligible for full-time employment, Section 1, 2, 3 supersedes.

Section 5: Mason County employees who have not reached the new salary schedule as listed above, but who have filled the time requirements, shall receive the salary according to the schedule listed above.

Section 6: This resolution shall be in full force and effect as of the 1st day of January, 1981.
