COUNTY ROAD PROJECT No. 938

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 1300 known locally as the Dickenson Avenue Road, and more specifically located in Section 29, T. 20 N., R. 3 W., W.M., M.P. to M.P. , work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is hereby made a part of the officially adopted county annual road program pursuant to RCW 36.81.130 and assigned # 15-B thereon,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to

Widen to twenty feet and pave with bituminous surface treatment 0.50 mile of Dickenson Avenue. Included in this project would be approximately one-quarter mile of pre-level with asphalt concrete on both sides of the existing paved surface to restore the geometric cross-section prior to sealing.

and that said work is to be performed by (day labor) (~~contract~~) in accordance with the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:
