

RESOLUTION OF ESTABLISHMENT NO. 52-81

of

COUNTY ROADS

(Plat of Lakeland Village No. 9)

WHEREAS, on April 20, 1981, the Board of County Commissioners did pass and approve a Resolution of Intention to Establish "all roads dedicated to the public" in the Plat of Lakeland Village No. 9, as recorded in Volume 10 Pages 34 and 35, records of Mason County, Washington as County Roads; and,

WHEREAS, after due Notice and Public Hearing, pursuant to law, and after careful consideration and study of the report submitted by the Mason County Engineer, finds that the establishment is a public necessity and practicable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners, that the roads as listed below, be established as a part of the Mason County Road System, and the Mason County Engineer be directed to proceed with said establishment.

Elma's Place Co. Rd. No. 67110 (.05 mi.)
