COUNTY ROAD PROJECT No. 954

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 9819 known locally as the North Shore Road, and more specifically located in                     , M.P. 9.00 to M.P. 10.75, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is identified as # 18 on the officially adopted county annual road program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to improve 1.75 miles of the North Shore Road by widening, pre-leveling and paving twenty-two (22) feet wide, one and one-half inches compacted with asphalt Concrete Class-"B".

and that said work is to be performed by ~~(BAY LABOR)~~ (contract) in accordance with the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:
