

ORDINANCE NO. 70-81

AMENDMENTS TO
MASON COUNTY PARKING STANDARDS ORDINANCE NO. 815

WHEREAS, the Board of Mason County Commissioners, did, on October 17, 1977, adopt the Mason County Parking Standards Ordinance No. 815; and

WHEREAS, certain amendments, deletions and additions were deemed necessary to said Parking Standards Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mason County Commissioners held a Public Hearing on June 1, 1981, to consider proposed amendments, deletions and additions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following amendments to the Parking Standards Ordinance be adopted:

SECTION 9.04, COMMERCIAL, Subsection 7. Marinas, not including sales and service:

Delete paving requirements.

Change parking space requirements to read:

"One parking space for each 3 permanently assigned moorage spaces and/or, at the owner's option, one parking space for each 60 feet or portion of 60 feet of non-assigned moorage space area.

Temporary moorage used for fueling and supplying boats shall not be included in the requirement for parking spaces. No temporary moorage will be used for any overnight moorage."
