

AMENDMENTS TO MASON COUNTY SANITARY CODE, ARTICLE VII

WHEREAS, the Board of Health for Mason County on December 18, 1978, adopted the rules and regulations of the Thurston-Mason Health District effective January 1, 1979 according to RCW 70.05.060 (3); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health desires the designer program be feasible and protect the public health; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health held a Public Hearing on July 7, 1981, for the purpose of reviewing the proposed amendments, deletions and additions to the Mason County Sanitary Code Article VII;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the following amendments, deletions and additions to Mason County Sanitary Code, Article VII, be adopted:

CHANGE SECTION 12.3 TO READ:

12.3 A bond for \$2,500.00 in favor of Mason County Health Department shall be provided by the applicant prior to issuance or renewal of a Commercial Designer's Certificate of Competency. The bond must be maintained for at least thirty (30) months from Certificate termination date. Also, a Commercial Designer shall warrant the design to be adequate for the level of use stated on the sewage system permit application form. This warranty shall be for thirty (30) months from the final approval of the sewage system. The warranty shall be to the benefit of the property owner, or any subsequent purchasers, heirs or assigns. The designer shall certify that the installed system meets the design specifications he/she has required.

This Article shall be amended and shall be in full force and effective on September 1, 1981.
