

ORDINANCE NO. 92-81

AMENDMENT TO MASON COUNTY CODE, CHAPTER 14.28

MASON COUNTY ADDRESSING ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of Mason County Commissioners, on December 17, 1979, adopted the Mason County Addressing Ordinance No. 1091, to establish a uniform road location and structure numbering system to reduce confusion of emergency or municipal service agencies in locating specific structures; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance did not provide for exemptions from the Mason County Addressing Program; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held on August 3, 1981, by the Board of Mason County Commissioners to consider amending Mason County Code, Chapter 14.28, to make provision for exemptions from the Addressing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mason County Commissioners feels it is in the best interest of Mason County to make said provision in the Mason County Addressing Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that the following amendment be made to the Mason County Code, Chapter 14.28:

Change Chapter 14.28.030 to read:

Scope. All addressable structures as defined in this chapter shall be subject to the minimum requirements of this chapter provided that the Mason County Board of Commissioners may exempt an area upon request of the residents therein if the present system of addresses in the area is adequate to meet the purposes of this chapter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this chapter shall be amended, in full force and effective on August 3, 1981.
