COUNTY ROAD PROJECT No. 950

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 5071 known locally as the Capital Hill Road, and more specifically located in _____, M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 1.25, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is identified as # 9 on the officially adopted county annual road program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to

Construct 1.25 miles of new County road by grading, draining and surfacing with ten inches of gravel base.

and that said work is to be performed by ~~(day labor)~~ (contract) in accordance with the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:
