COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION No. 23-82

COUNTY ROAD PROJECT No. 967

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 9110 known locally as the Arcadia Road Road, and more specifically located in _____, M.P. 1.45 to M.P. 2.87, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is identified as # 13 on the officially adopted county annual road program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to improve 1.42 miles of the Arcadia Road by paving with Class "B" Asphalt Concrete, twenty-two feet (22') wide, with a compacted depth of one and one-quarter inches (1 1/4"). Included in this project will be the paving of four V-12 design intersections.

and that said work is to be performed by (~~day labor~~) (contract) in accordance with the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:
