

RESOLUTION NO. 29-82

SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1982, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriations to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to a grant from the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation, State of Washington, in the amount of \$243,750, for improvements to the Mason County Recreation Area.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners:

That the 5th day of April, 19 82, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock in the morning, the Board of County Commissioners of Mason County, at the County Courthouse in Shelton, Washington, be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation to the budget for the Parks Acquisition & Development fund, in the estimated amount of \$ 243,750, for the above-mentioned purposes, and the Clerk of the Board be and hereby is authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.
