COUNTY ROAD PROJECT No. 976

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 8587 known locally as the Larson Lake Road Road, and more specifically located in Sec. 31, T23N, R1W, W.M., M.P. \_\_\_\_\_ to M.P. \_\_\_\_\_, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is identified as # 17 on the officially adopted county annual road program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to do minor widening by clearing, grading & draining and widening and leveling with asphalt concrete.

Clear, grade & drain	\$8,200
Ballast	1,500
A. C. leveling	5,300
Total	15,000

and that said work is to be performed by (day labor) (~~contract~~) in accordance with the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:
