WHEREAS, the Board of Mason County Commissioners have received a petition to vacate a	L
public right-of-way in the Plat of <u>the Town of Allyn</u> ,	
as recorded in Volume $\underline{1}$, Page $\underline{17}$ of Plats and filed on the $\underline{6th}$	_
day of <u>September</u> , <u>1889</u> , records of Mason County, Washington.	
WHEREAS, the petition to vacate describes the following roads, streets and alleys:	
Alley between Blocks Sixty-eight (68) and Sixty-nine (69) of the Town of	
Allyn, Washington	
WHEREAS, the laws of the State of Washington of 1889 - 1890, Chapter XIX, Section 32,	
Page 603 mandated that "Any county road which remains unopened for publi	С
use for the space of five years after the authority (is) granted for	
opening the same, shall be and the same is hereby vacated "	
WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of Washington has mandated in Turner V. Davisson, 47 Wn.	
2d 375 (1955), that the above law shall govern the vacation of roads unopened	
for five (5) years prior to March 12, 1909 in any plat recorded before March 12,	,
1904.	
WHEREAS, there is no evidence that the petitioned right-of-way was improved or opened	l
for public use during the first five years after the filing date, nor is it evi-	-
dent that this said right-of-way was ever open to the public.	
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Mason County Commissioners recognize	2S
that said petitioned right-of-way was vacated by operation of law as of the 7th	
day of <u>September</u> , <u>1904</u> , on which date Mason County lost any and al	1
claim to said petitioned right-of-way.
