

RESOLUTION NO. 18-87

WHEREAS, RCW 36.32.270 authorized the County Commissioners to dispense with bidding requirements in an emergency situation when public safety or property are damaged or threatened; and,

WHEREAS, a tractor was stolen from the Mason County Recreation Area (MCRA) and it is necessary to have a tractor/mower to maintain the park fields for scheduled events, and

WHEREAS, the County will receive reimbursement for the majority of the cost to replace the tractor/mower from the County's General; Property Insurance policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that an emergency as defined by RCW 36.32.270 does exist and that the General Services Director is authorized to proceed immediately to procure a new tractor/mower off the bid from Lakewood Lawn & Equipment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Mason County Commissioners hereby approves the emergency appropriation of \$6,908.36 to the budget of General Services - Parks & Administration to be expended for the above said purchase, as follows:


