

RESOLUTION NO 43-87

CENTENNIAL FUND ESTABLISHED

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1987, it is necessary to establish a budget for the Mason County Centennial Committee to receive state shared revenue for conducting centennial related planning and activities in Mason County.


WHEREAS, a public hearing was conducted according to published notice in the official paper as provided by law,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that a special revenue fund known as the **Centennial Committee** is established. The total appropriated amount available for expenditure in 1987 will be \$6,725.00.

The County Auditor is hereby authorized to issue warrants for regularly approved claims for such purposes up to the said amount.


